40 Days for Life features three components:

**PRAYER AND FASTING:** On March 16, join Indianapolis area believers for a united day of fervent prayer and fasting for an end to abortion.

**PEACEFUL VIGIL:** Shine a light on abortion in our community by peacefully praying in front of Planned Parenthood, 8590 Georgetown Road, Indianapolis, the busiest abortion center in Indiana.

**COMMUNITY OUTREACH:** Promote grassroots education in our community by distributing information through our churches, neighborhoods, families and friends and by contacting our legislators and encouraging them to support laws to protect human life.

Since the first 40 Days for Life campaign in 2007:

**750,000** people in over 816 cities have joined to pray and fast for an end to abortion.

**18,000** churches have participated in 40 Days for Life campaigns.

**16,742** lives have been reported as spared from abortion – and those are just the ones we know about.

**196** abortion workers have quit their jobs and walked away from the abortion industry.

**104** abortion facilities have completely shut down following local 40 Days for Life campaigns.


